To obtain good results, it's suggested to use thin paper. Origami paper is perfect, normal paper for copies (80 gr/sm) is too thick, better if 60 gr/sm.

Cut out the rectangles (which are in 1 x $\sqrt{3}$ ratio) paying attention to cut away the black line on upper edge of the module (just over the 2007).

Fold modules following Carmen's diagrams starting from page 2.

Folded modules must be joined in pairs, choosing two months whose sum is equal to 13. Es:

January (1) + December (12) = 13

February (2) + November (11) = 13, and so on.

Join the couples together as per Carmen's instruction, following months order. Be very quiet and calm when putting the last couple!

You can decide either to fold all the modules with white paper to obtain a "snow flake" effect, either to choose one color for January to June and a second one for July to December, to obtain a "windrose" effect.
