Best paper: Tissue foil



1. Begin with a A4 rectangle and divide it in 4 parts.



2. Take only one part of the rectangle.



3. Fold in half.



4. Fold in half.



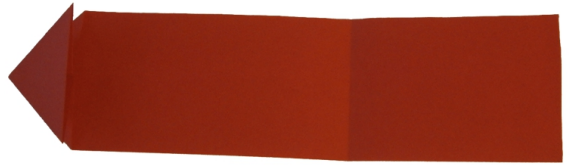
5. Take only
3/4 of the rectangle.



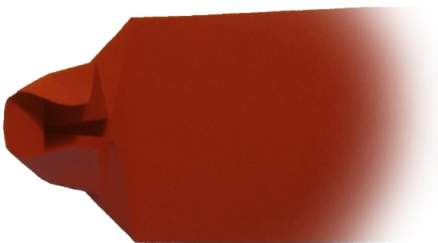
6. Ok. Now we can start.
Fold a waterbomb base
on the top of the rectangle



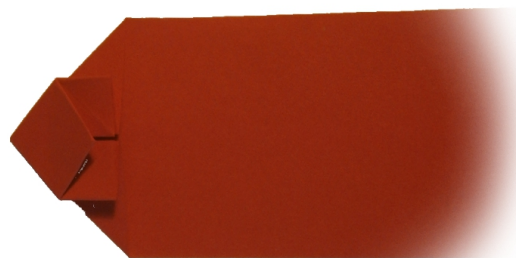
7. In progress.



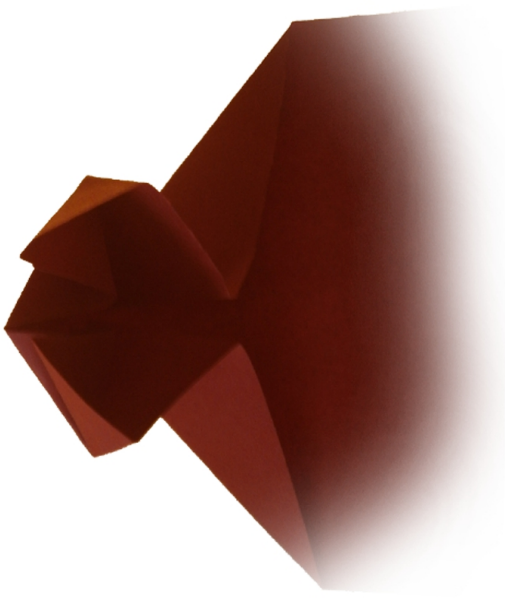
8. Make a petal fold.



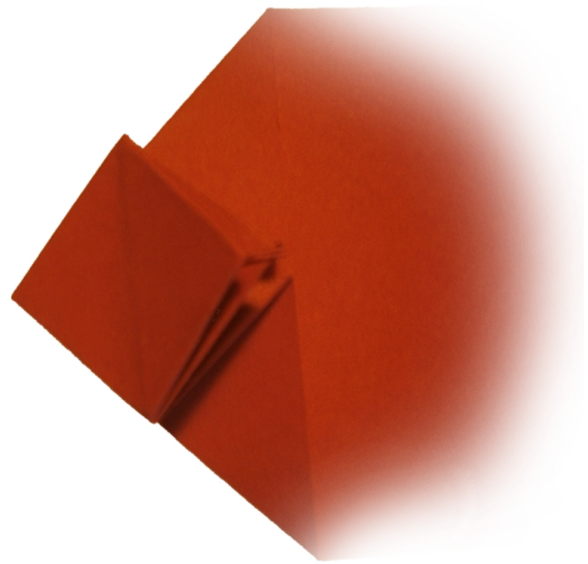
9. In progress.

two flaps behind.



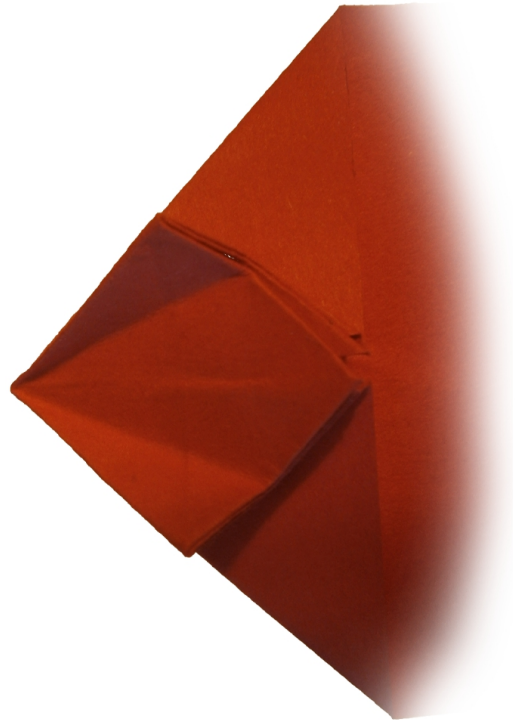
11. In progress.



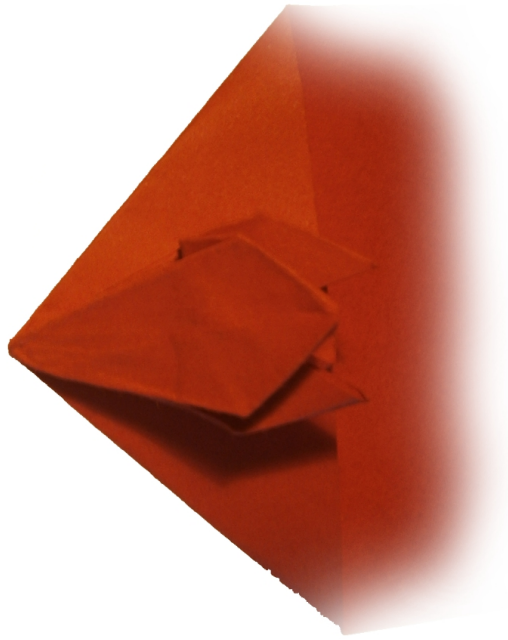
12. Fold two sides of the square to the centre.



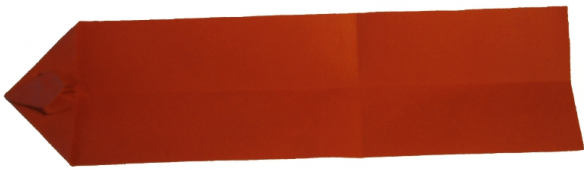
13. Now unfold...

17. Petal fold.



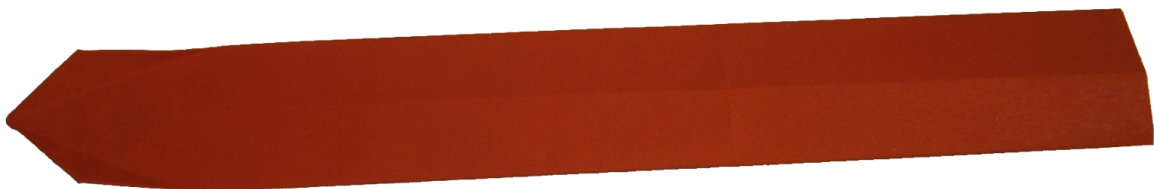
18. Turn the model over.



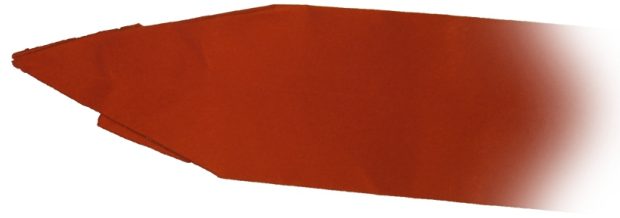
19. Fold two sides at the top to the centre.

22. Fold the top part to the existing line and unfold.



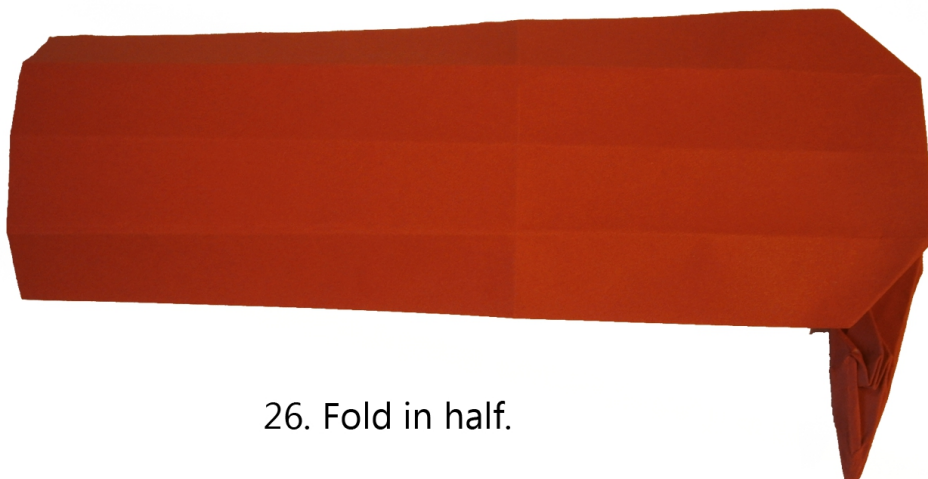
23. Rabbit ear fold. Use the line as a reference.



24. Turn the model over.



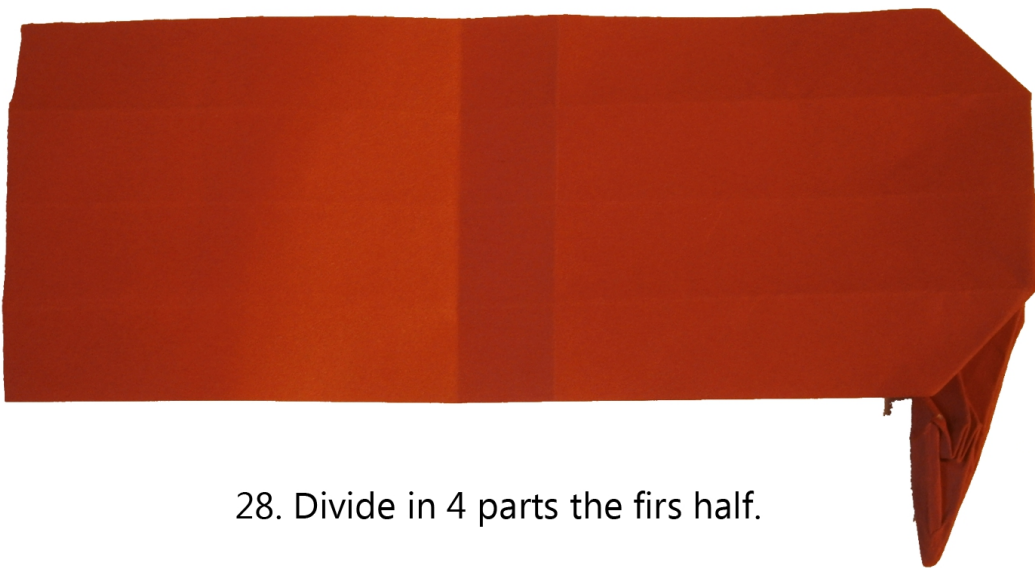
25. Open two flaps and collapse on the other side.



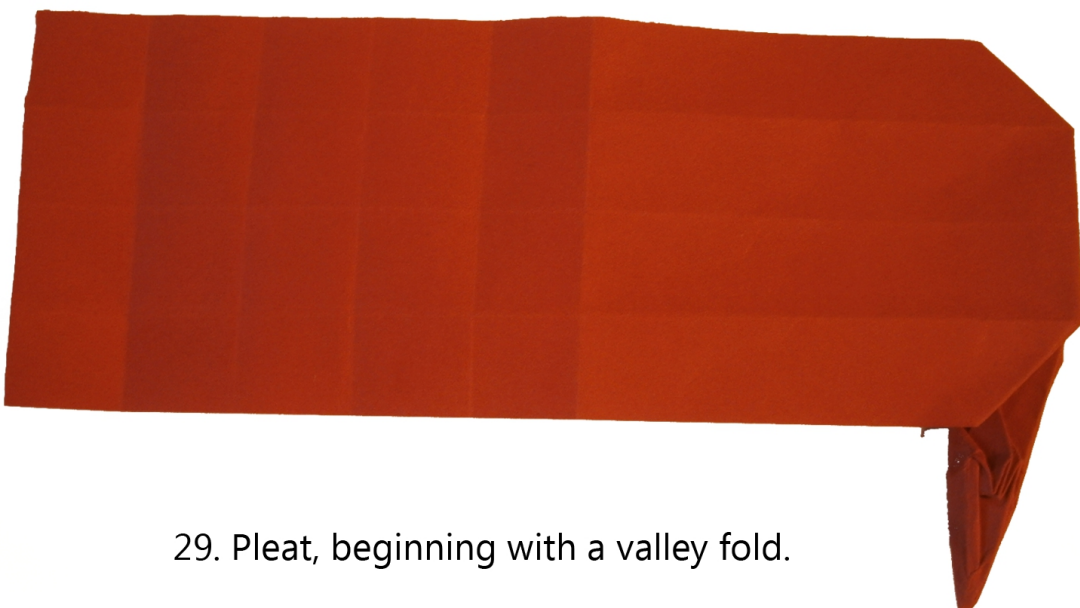
26. Fold in half.



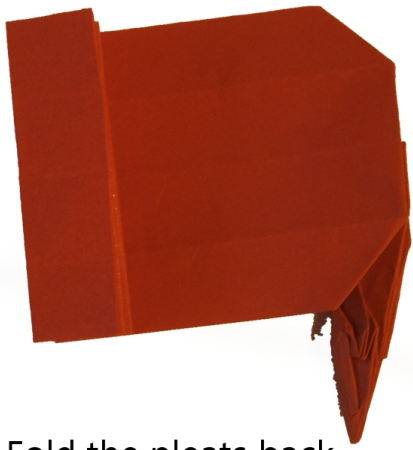
27. Unfold.



28. Divide in 4 parts the first half.



29. Pleat, beginning with a valley fold.



30. Fold the pleats back with another pleat.



31. Fold the pleats up with another pleat.



32. Valley fold.



33. Turn the model over.



34. Rotate



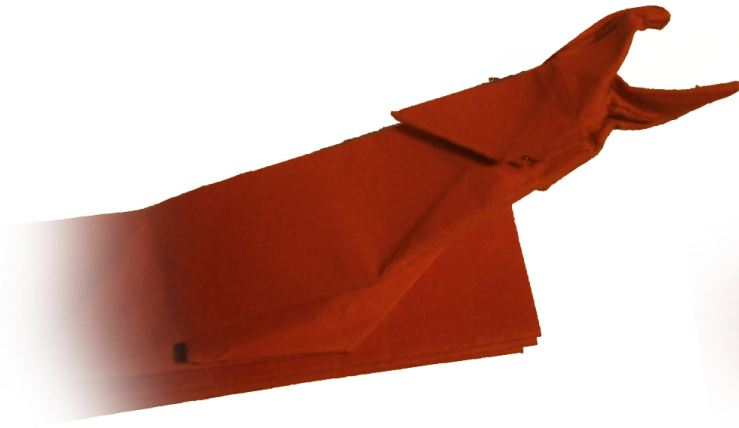
35. Fold one side of the head up.
Repeat on the other side



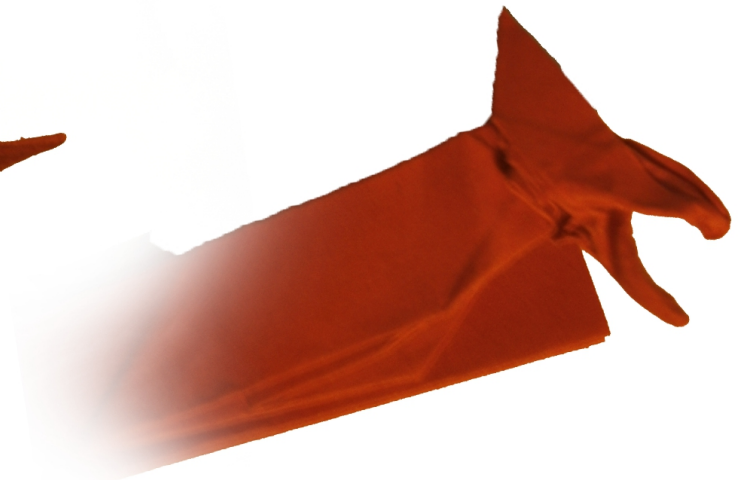
36. Fold the head forward to his position.



37. Crimp the nose and shape the mouth



38. Crimp the head.



39. Shape the horns.



40. Crimp the neck.



41. Fold the model in half.



42. Curve the two flaps



43. Shape the model.
