




5. Now fold the flap back out, as shown in figure 5.









7. Foldthe entire model in half.

8. Always remember, that unless otherwise noted, what you do to one side of a model, must also be done to the other side as well. Fold the top of the model in ward even with the crease.









13. Fold in the sides of the figure to the center, then fold them back out and using those folds as guides fold the tip of the flap all the way back to the rear of the model, if done correctly that little portion of the model will look like figure 2.

14. Fold the top edge of bottom down as, shown in the illustration.



15. Now reach in side the model, and pull down the little flap to make the feet.



16. Now for the fun part, hold the model at the places marked in figure 16 by circles, then pull back and down on the circle on the feet, and it will flap its wings.
