Without overlapping, construct the Italian Flag from the six pieces.

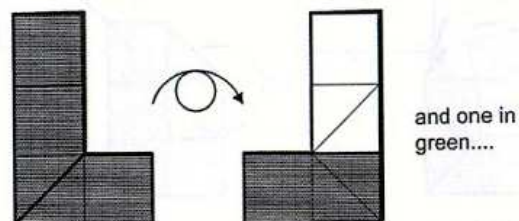
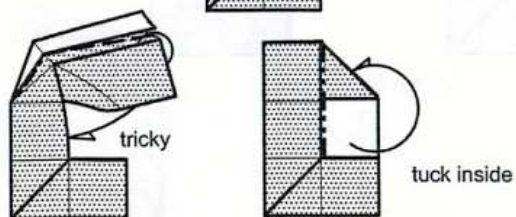


ITALIAN FLAG PUZZLE by Mick Guy

 Modules One and Two - begin with one piece of red paper and one piece of green.



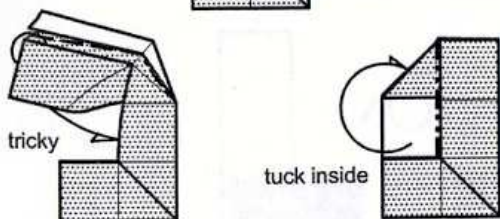
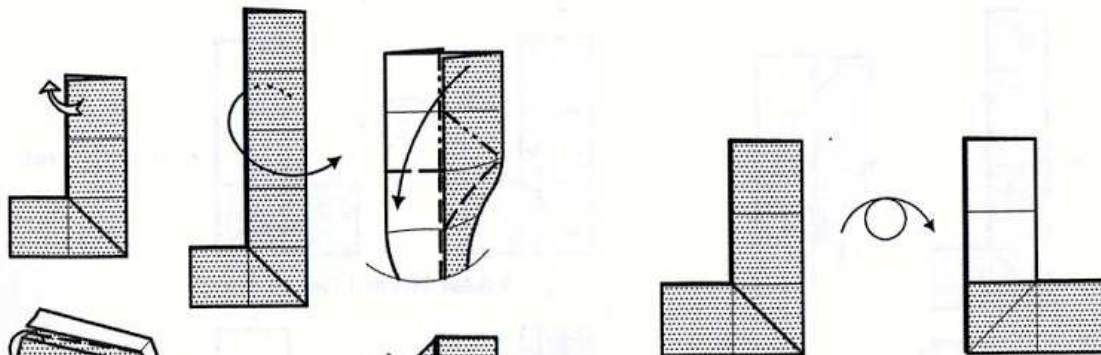
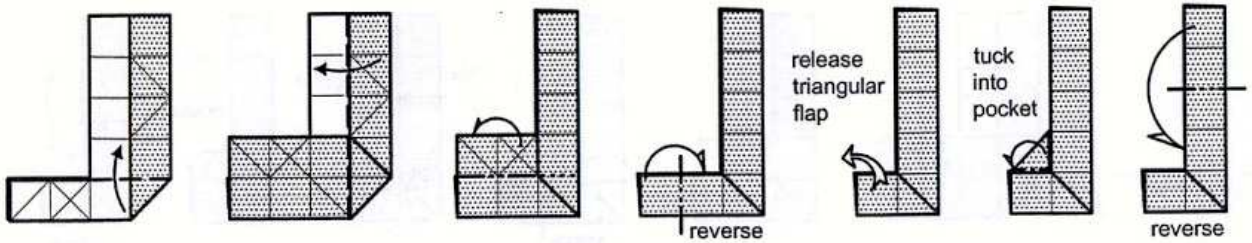
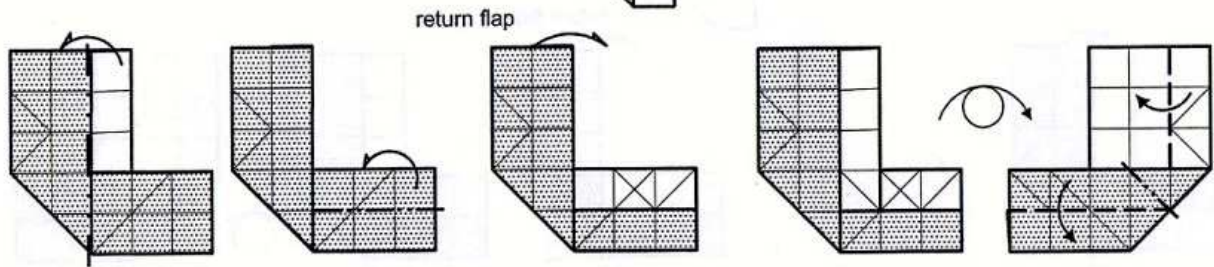
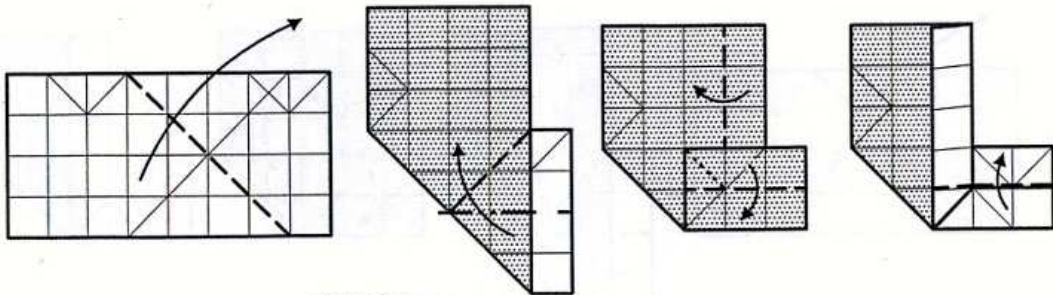
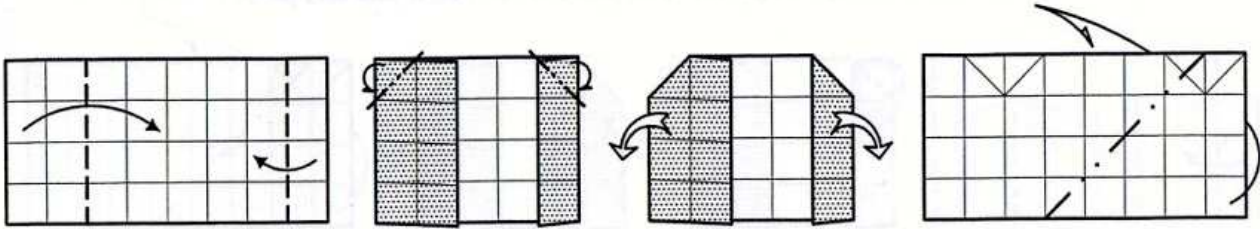

Use red paper.

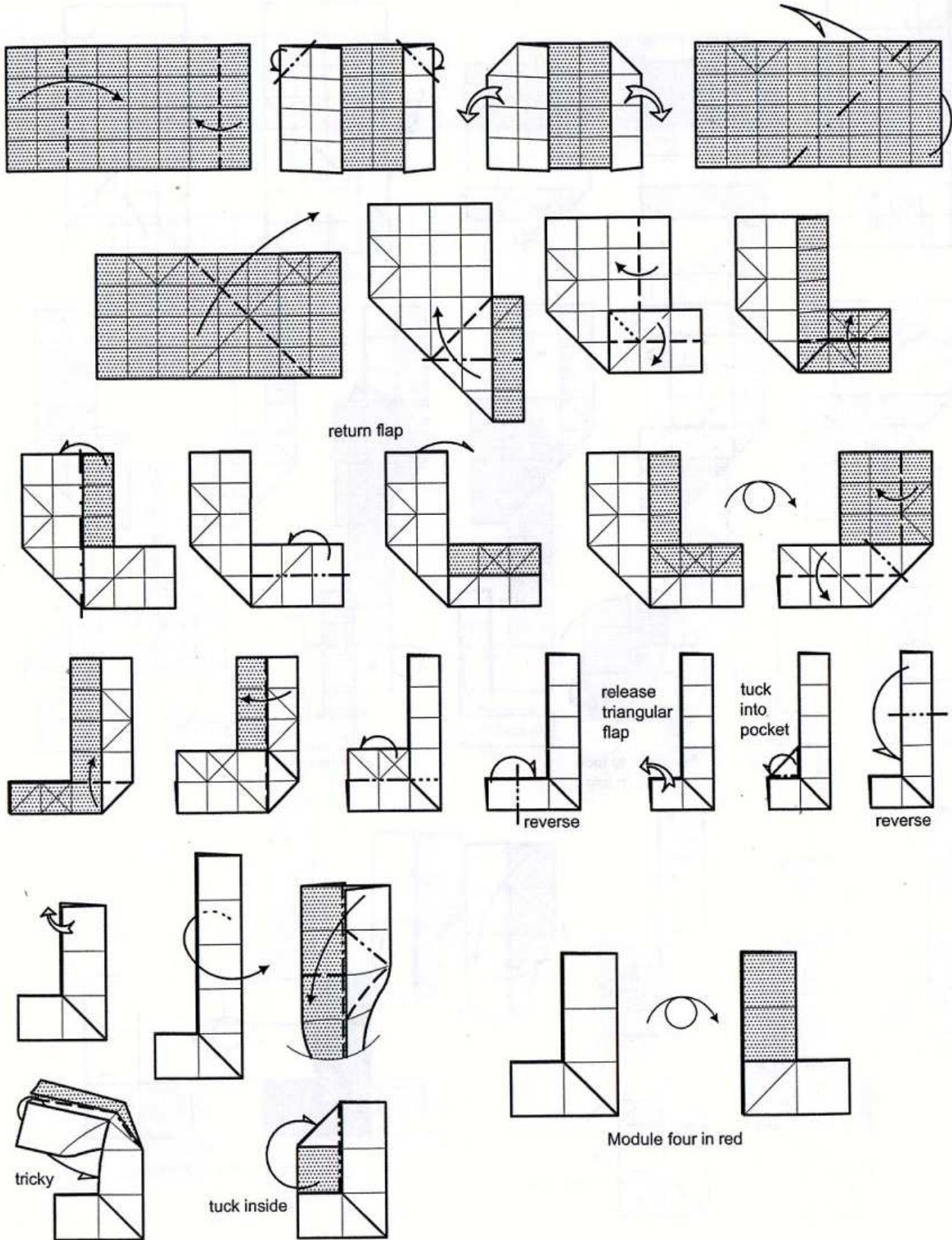


Module three in red

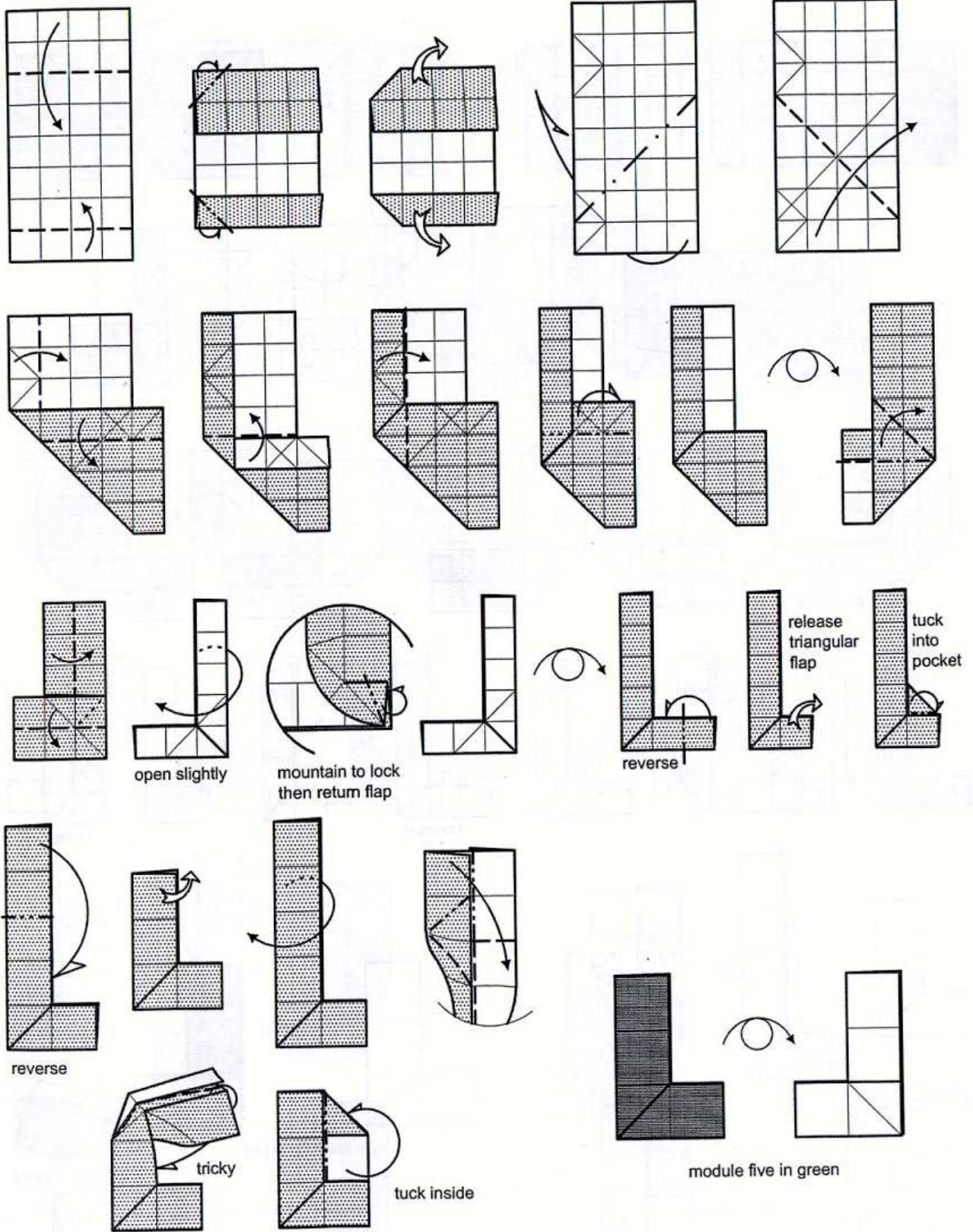
